



GENERAL TAKEAWAYS



- Energy environment has dramatically changed
- Army and the Department of Defense is now being challenged by near peer adversaries that have significantly changed our National Defense Strategy and priorities

□ Measurement & Verification (M&V) Witnessing

- > ESCO coordinate with Government POC
- Must have Government representative participate in annual M&V activities
